

# Interpreter Interface



- 1 Session name**  
Indicates the name of the session or event.
- 2 Interface & media settings**  
Select a video window layout; refresh the session; select the interface language, configure the mic/speakers, test your connection; see your display name; Exit the session and log out of your KUDO account.
- 3 Outgoing Channel panel**  
Add the language(s) you may need to use in the Configuration window. Press a button to select the language you will be interpreting into.
- 4 Incoming Channel panel**  
Add auxiliary languages in case you need to take relay.
- 5 Video window**  
Embedded video or presentation window.
- 6 Microphone On/Off button**  
Activate your microphone to start interpreting. A RED button indicates it is LIVE (hot). A GREEN button means it is off.
- 7 Channel Busy indicator**  
This indicator will light up (blue) if the channel you are trying to enable is occupied.
- 8 Mute (Cough) button**  
Mute/Unmute. When active, the Mic button will display as crossed.
- 9 Floor Incoming selector**  
Default incoming channel. It brings you the audio of everything that is said on the Floor.
- 10 Incoming volume control**  
Use the slider and loudspeaker icon to control and mute the sound level you hear.
- 11 Flor Mix control**  
Control the dual listening feature to hear Floor and incoming channel simultaneously.
- 12 Boothmate Handover**  
Control and prompts for the Handover feature.
- 13 Messaging tab**  
Select the chat channels to communicate with fellow interpreters and operators.
- 14 Polls tab**  
Access poll questions and check its results.
- 15 Documents tab**  
Access to view and download documents shared on the session.
- 16 Request list tab**  
See the participants who have requested to speak.
- 17 Shortcut list**  
Dis play a list of keyboard shortcuts to control the interpreter interface.
- 18 Leave/End the session**  
Leave the session without logging out of your KUDO account, or leave and end the session for everyone.
